esh from Cairo, **Iason Athanasiadis** will share about the 24 crucial hours spent inside hrir Square on the Wednesday night/Thursday morning when the Mubarak loyalists tacked and how it turned the entire momentum from one of violent repression to one negotiations and concessions. Athanasiadis is a Farsi-speaking journalist who irrently resides in Afghanistan. He studied Arabic and Modern Middle Eastern Studies Oxford and was a 2008 Nieman fellow at Harvard. He studied for a Masters at the anian Foreign Ministry's think-tank in Tehran and was imprisoned in Tehran's Evin ison on espionage charges during the 2009 post-election unrest.
